## **SAFETY AND LIABILITY**

Reasonable precautions for safety will be taken, but the Emmet-Charlevoix Fair Advisory Council, Emmet County and Charlevoix County, and their commissioners, officers, employees and agents will not be responsible or liable for any injury, loss or damage of any kind. There are risks and hazards inherent in attractions and events at the fair that may cause conditions to become hazardous or dangerous to persons, animals and personal property on the fairgrounds.

People entering the grounds will do so at their own risk. No dogs will be allowed on the midway or near the food vendors. Dogs are allowed on grass areas only, and must be on a leash at all times. Service dogs are exempt, however, must be able to show proof of being a service dog.

**The unauthorized use of all-terrain vehicles, segways, golf carts, or other such low speed vehicles (except motorized wheelchairs) is prohibited. Skateboards, bicycles, mopeds, etc. will not be allowed in any areas of the fairgrounds.**

*Alcoholic Beverages Are Strictly Prohibited on the Fairgrounds unless in a Designated Area*

*Smoking is Strictly Prohibited in any Fair Building*

## **RULES AND REGULATIONS**

### **OFFICERS**

During the fair, the Manager will be the executive officer in charge of all exhibit project areas of the fair. He/she will be on the grounds throughout the days of the fair, and will be available to review all complaints and necessary adjustments. The Manager will have charge of the receiving and recording of all entries, the allotment of display space, the listing of premiums and directions of concessions.

Each superintendent will be in charge of an exhibit project area. Exhibitors and judges will apply to such superintendent for instructions in their department. Once an item has been displayed in any category or class in the fair book, it is ineligible to be shown again, with the exception of antiques.

### **GENERAL RULES FOR ANIMALS**

Only one entry per animal class. No animals may compete for more than one prize in any class or division unless by reason of special exception to the rule referred to elsewhere. Animals, birds, or other projects may be entered in only "Open Class" or "4-H" but not both. No for sale signs will be allowed on entries at the fair, private treaty sales of animals must be handled by the appropriate barn superintendent.

Exhibitors participating in the Emmet and Charlevoix County 4-H Program may not show the same species through 4-H in any other country fair during the current year: Any 4-H market animal exhibited cannot have been shown or sold at another county fair during this calendar year. Consequences include all awards/honors/titles may be forfeited or recalled and the exhibitor may NOT participate in said fair the following calendar year.

All livestock shown must be the bona-fide property of the exhibitor at the time of making entry. Exhibitors must furnish all supplies, feed and bedding. All livestock and small animals must be vet/health checked prior to unloading from trailers and placing into barns.

4-H Exhibits must be registered by Monday, July 20th. Fair books can be picked up at the fair office.

4-H exhibitor projects can be brought to Barn #2 on Friday, August 21st from 4:00 pm to 7:00 pm or Saturday, August 22nd from 9am to 11am. This includes all projects and Animal Husbandry record books.

## **MDARD HEALTH REQUIREMENTS**

To exhibit, livestock exhibitors must be in compliance with animal health requirements as defined by the Department of Agriculture Rural Development. The full version of the MDARD Health requirements are located in the fair office, or can be accessed on the department web site at [www.michigan.gov/mdafairregs](http://www.michigan.gov/mdafairregs).

## **DRUG TESTING POLICY AND PROCEDURES**

The Emmet Charlevoix County Fair reserves the right to drug test any or all livestock entered in the fair if deemed necessary by the Fair Management. The expense for drug testing is the responsibility of the person(s) owning the animal(s) if the test results show proof of improper use of drugs. The full policy is available in the fair office.

## **PROTESTS (APPEALS AND COMPLAINTS)**

An exhibitor compelled to bring a complaint regarding conflict of interest of the judge, disqualification of an exhibit or exhibitor's group leader or superintendent's behavior, or eligibility of an exhibit shall make a formal protest in writing to the Fair Board no later than ten days following the end of fair. No protests will be accepted unless in writing.

All protests shall be referred to the Executive Board, which shall review the protest with interested parties and give parties an opportunity to submit evidence. The party against whom the protest was filed shall have the right to read the statement of protest.

A report of findings shall be made to the Fair Board for final decision on the protest within 10 days of the original complaint. The Fair Board shall issue an opinion within 2 weeks of receiving the recommendations from the Executive Board.

An exhibitor may file an appeal to the Department of Agriculture/Rural Development within 45 days of filing the initial complaint if the exhibitor is not satisfied with the Association's action. The Department of Agriculture/Rural Development shall have 60 days after receipt of any appropriately filed appeal to investigate the complaint, and issue a finding of fact and notice of department action and any recommended actions for the Association.

Exhibitors not satisfied with the awarding of premiums may file with the Manager up to 10 days after the close of the fair and 45 days with MDARD. Their protest must be in writing specifying their cause of complaint. Action on the same will be taken at the first meeting of the Fair Advisory Council when all parties should be present.

## EXHIBITORS

Every effort has been made to make this year's book as complete as possible. Exhibitors should examine this premium book in order to thoroughly understand the manner in which the fair is conducted, and to prevent mistakes that could occur. Entries are to be made only in classes as listed in the fair premium book. No special classes will be accepted. Once an item has been displayed in any category or class, it is ineligible to be shown again.

Take no heed of rumors in regard to the business of the fair; read the rules; and if in doubt as to what to do, inquire of those whose business it is to assist you. It is desirable that entries be made in advance of the opening of the fair.

Fair Books are available at the Emmet County MSU Extension Office at 3434 Harbor-Petoskey Road, Harbor Springs, at the Charlevoix County MSU Extension Office, located at 319-B N. Lake Street, Boyne City, the fair website or at the fair office. 4-H exhibitors must be registered by Monday, July 20th. Any assistance required or instructions on the procedures for making entries will be provided.

**Open class entries** will be accepted in the Community Center at the fairgrounds on **SUNDAY ONLY**, August 23rd, 10:00am - 6:00pm.

Tags will be printed at the registration desk directly from Fair Entry upon check-in on Sunday. THERE WILL BE NO MORE HAND WRITTEN TAGS. We do have an option to pre-print your tags at home, upon registration completion, if you choose. All Community building exhibits will be released from 9:00am to 2:00pm on Sunday, August 30th. Please be prompt in picking up exhibits. Positively no exhibits will be released on Saturday.

- \* Open Class exhibitors must be at least 5 years of age by January 1, 2026.
- \* Pre-registration online is encouraged
- \* When space has been awarded to any exhibitor the Board reserves the right in case any such exhibitor shall fail to make or maintain a creditable display, to declare the space allotted to him or any portion thereof forfeited.
- \* No person shall be allowed to act as judge of any class in which he or she is a competitor and no premium will be paid to anyone in any way trying to influence the decision of the judges. Do not place name of owner or advertising of any kind on exhibits prior to their having been judged.

All entries must be made and shown in the name of the owner or joint owners, or actual grower, producers, inventors or manufacturers, except where the article is a portion of an entry made by an organized group of which they are a member or disqualification may occur. Groups must enter group projects only, not individual projects.

All exhibitors must keep their stalls and surroundings in a neat and healthful condition the entire week. This includes feeding, caring, grooming and completing the required barn duties. When animals are brought out for exhibition or examination, it will be expected that the person in charge will be presentable and courteous.

Every article or animal upon the fairgrounds will be under control of the Fair Board. The fair will have a watchman on duty both day and night. While the fair provides this precautionary measure for the protection of all exhibits and articles brought upon the grounds, it will not be responsible for loss or injury to articles or animals on exhibition (or on the fairgrounds) and upon which conditions all entries are accepted.

Early removal of any exhibit shall cause forfeiture of entire fair premium check and suspension from participation in the fair for the following year or community service as deemed by a committee appointed by the Fair President.

## **NO CHARGE FOR EXHIBIT ENTRIES**

No free passes will be given to anyone. Persons wishing to pass in and out of the grounds at will can purchase a weekly pass. THESE PASSES ARE NOT TRANSFERABLE.

Daily entry into the fair will be \$6.00 for each person 13 years old and older. A weekly gate pass for 4-H (13-19 yrs) exhibitors and Senior Citizens (60 years and older) is \$6.00. All other weekly gate passes are \$10.00 (Children 12 & under are free). Mega Ride passes are \$90.00 (only if purchased prior to the carnival opening) which will allow you to ride all week long when the carnival is open. After the carnival opens, the price for the Mega Ride pass will be \$100.00. Daily Ride Bands are also available prior to the carnival opening; prices vary based on the day chosen and you can purchase these in the fair office.

## **JUDGING OF EXHIBITS**

Judges in the various departments have been given authority to decide, where there is but one exhibit in any class or department, whether the exhibitor is entitled to prize money or a special ribbon. No person shall be appointed as judge or allowed to act where he or any member of his/her family is an exhibitor. No person shall be permitted to interfere with the judging committee while performing their duty of examination. In case of doubt as to their power, the committee may refer to the Superintendent in charge of the division, who if necessary will lay the matter before the executive officers. The placement in any class is up to the judge's discretion, and the judge's decision is final.

## **NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS**

For payment of premiums, all awards will be subject to the following:  
All premium awards are subject to a pro-rata reduction based on availability of funds.

**All premium check must be presented for payment within 60 days after the day of issuance or they will considered a donation to the fair.**

# RABBITS, POULTRY & POCKET PETS

All poultry must be free from lice and other infestations. No infested birds will be allowed to be exhibited. Pair classes shall consist of a rooster and a hen, or a cockerel and a pullet, of the same breed and variety. Chicks must be at least 3 weeks old to be on exhibit. Pen class needs to include: 2 of the same breed and variety. No poultry or fowl shall be handled by anyone other than the registered exhibitor. Neither the fair board nor the county will accept any liability for injuries (animal or human) if exhibits are handled by anyone other than the exhibitor.

\*NOTE: the doe & litter rabbit classes are to promote the represented breed and must be 3 weeks of age. Doe & litter mixed breeds class will be based on meat qualities only. Entries that are not commercial/meat type will be penalized.

All exhibits must be in secure cages - One entry per class

All exhibitors must print Township and Section number on Pullorum test forms. Pullorum testing for all poultry will be Sunday, August 23rd from 9:00am to 11:30am

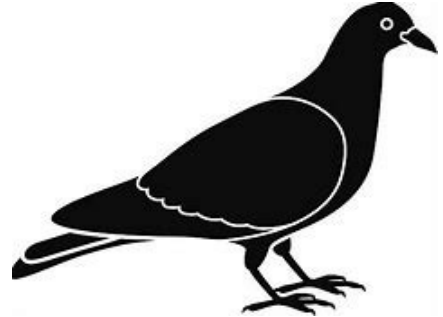

# RANCH RIDING SHOW

**Saturday, August 15th Starts No Earlier Than 3:00pm Following Pleasure**

The purpose of the ranch riding class is to measure the ability of the horse to be a pleasure to ride while being used as a means of conveyance from performing one ranch task to another. The horse should reflect the versatility, attitude and movement of a working ranch horse riding outside the confines of an arena. The horse should be well-trained, relaxed, quiet, soft and cadenced at all gaits. The ideal ranch horse will travel with forward movement and demonstrate an obvious lengthening of stride at extended gaits. The horse can be ridden with light contact or on a relatively loose rein without requiring undue restraint, but not shown on a full drape of reins. The overall manners and responsiveness of the ranch riding horse to make timely transitions in a smooth and correct manner, as well as the quality of the movement are of primary considerations. The ideal ranch riding horse should have a natural ranch horse appearance from head to tail in each maneuver.

**BITS:** A snaffle bit is allowed for any aged horse. A curb bit must be ridden in one hand. Bitless bridles, including the bosal, sidepull, and halter, are allowed for any aged horse.

**\*\*Tack should have little to no silver. No bands and no braids.\*\***

1 $\frac{3}{4}$ cups (217g) all-purpose flour	1 cup (90g) shredded carrots (see note)
$\frac{1}{2}$ teaspoon baking soda	$\frac{1}{2}$ cup (56g) chopped pecans or walnuts
1 teaspoon cinnamon	Frosting
$\frac{1}{4}$ teaspoon salt	4 tablespoons (57g) unsalted butter, softened
$\frac{1}{2}$ cup (113g) unsalted butter, softened	4 ounces (112g) cream cheese, room temperature
$\frac{3}{4}$ cup (150g) packed brown sugar	1 $\frac{1}{2}$ cups (170g) powdered sugar
1 large egg	1 teaspoon vanilla
1 teaspoon vanilla extract	$\frac{1}{8}$ teaspoon salt

### Instructions

Preheat oven to 350°F. Line two cookie sheets with parchment paper or silicone baking mats.  
In a small bowl, whisk flour with baking soda, cinnamon and salt. Set aside.  
Cream butter and brown sugar in a large bowl with an electric mixer 1-2 minutes.  
Mix in egg and vanilla until smooth.  
Add dry ingredients to wet and mix until smooth. Stir in carrots and nuts.  
Scoop 2 tablespoon size balls onto cookie sheets 2-inches apart. Lightly flatten with the palms of your hand.  
Bake for 13-16 minutes or until no longer glossy. Cool before frosting.  
To make frosting: beat butter and cream cheese with an electric mixer until smooth.  
Slowly mix in powdered sugar then add vanilla and salt. Beat on medium high speed until smooth.  
Frost cookies as desired, top with a dusting of cinnamon or finely chopped nuts.  
Store in an airtight container for up to 3 days or freeze (frosted or unfrosted) for up to 2 months.

# 4-H YOUTH PROGRAMS

### **General Rules:**

This department is open to all youth ages 5-19 years old enrolled in registered 4-H Clubs in Emmet or Charlevoix County. For a 4-H member to participate in 4-H classes at the fair, they must be enrolled in Animal Husbandry, Horse or Market Livestock programs and abide by their rules. After May 1st, 4-H members may participate in open class entries. Check specific project areas for other earlier registration deadlines.

To exhibit in this department, a 4-H member must be currently registered with their county 4-H office in the project areas that they list on their fair premium statements. Ages for exhibitors are determined as of January 1 of the year of the fair. 4-H members must be at least 5 years old (by January 1, 2026) 4-H exhibitors between 5 & 7 years of age will receive "Cloverbud" participation ribbons only.

All exhibitors in the 4-H department are also subject to the "General Rules and Regulations" shown in the front of this book, including "State Health Regulations" for all livestock, as well as exhibitor limitations based on age.

All 4-H members and leaders are expected to conduct themselves respectfully while on the Emmet County Fairgrounds by being courteous to the rights of others, to assume any given responsibility and abide by their respective "code of conduct" statements, exhibitor agreements and county 4-H policies.

Exhibitors may not enter the same exhibit in a 4-H class and also in an open class. All 4-H members who register an animal entry must sign up and serve a barn duty shift or shifts in each barn they have animal exhibits according to the needs of the barn. An adult is strongly encouraged to sign up with children 10 years of age or younger.

All animal husbandry members are required to attend the meeting in August (cloverbuds are highly encouraged). All members exhibiting horses are required to attend the horse development council meeting in August. If unable to attend, exhibitor must make at least one of the Market Livestock meetings in July or August.

**Early removal of any exhibit shall cause forfeiture of entire fair premium check and suspension from participation in the fair for the following year or community service as deemed by a Committee appointed by the Fair President**

### **Registration Information**

A registration workshop will be held in the T-Barn from 6:00pm-7:00pm on Monday, July 20th. During that time, 4-H staff will be available to assist you in completing your fair entries, if needed. All entries in this department must be registered by 7:00 pm. on Monday, July 20th. This requirement applies to all Emmet and Charlevoix County 4-H entries. Entry tags and fair books may be picked up at either Extension Office or Fair Office. Entries not received by the deadline will only be eligible for open class exhibition.

### **4-H Project Judging**

4-H projects can be brought to Barn #2 from 4:00pm to 7:00pm on Friday, August 21st and 9:00am to 11:00am Saturday, August 22nd.

Barn #2 will then be closed from 11:00am to 1:00pm on Saturday, August 22nd for project judging. Clubs may return to set up their displays from 1:00pm to 6:00pm on Saturday, Aug 22 or Sunday from 12:00pm to 6:00pm on Sunday, Aug 23.

Cloverbud classes will be held prior to Animal Husbandry classes of that species. Animals do not need to be the property of the exhibitor.
